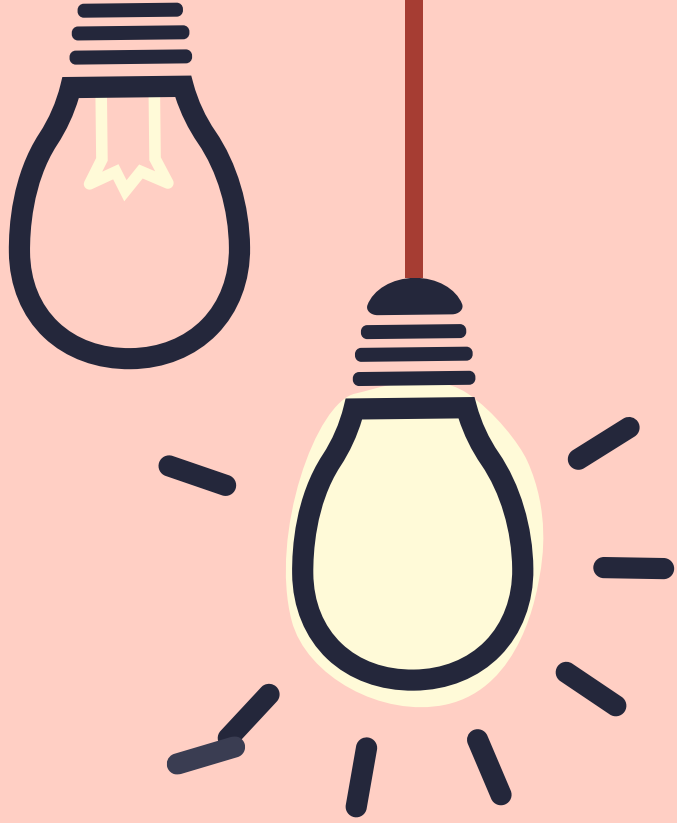

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MAKE IT PERSONAL

Capture your students' attention and interest with:

- an accessible format
- intriguing titles
- relevant graphics

DEFINE YOUR GOALS

Content: What should your students **know** by the end of your course?

Skills: What will your students to **be able to do**?

Affect: How will your students to **relate** to the material in the course?

CLARIFY YOUR EXPECTATIONS

- How will you measure **participation**?
- What is the **role** of homework?
- How do you measure **achievement**?

OUTLINE YOUR COURSE

What material can students expect to cover?

What big questions will they engage with?
